Health and Health Care are arguably the most important elements of a sustainable community. Sq'ewá:lxw entrusts the health care of our people to Stó:lō Health Services and as a result Sq'ewá:lxw does not have a direct role in health services delivery.

What Sq'ewá:lxw does have is the responsibility to ensure that health care services meet the needs of our people and contribute positively to the achievement of our vision for the future. Our role is to promote and influence the services offered and ensure that our members are aware of and have access to those services.

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Stó:lō Health Services

Based on the results of a survey conducted last year by the Vision Project Team, it was clear that although community members were positive about their health care experiences, they were not very familiar with the healthcare services available to them.

In answer to that knowledge gap, we invited Kelowa Edel of Stó:lō Health Services to our November sq'ép. Kelowa introduced to us her staff and the full range of health and medical services available. Those include:

- Health and safety
- Community health and home care including Health Nurses and Workers
- Home and community care
- Family empowerment supporting young mothers
- Wellness and Qwi:qwelstóm
- Crisis counseling
- Elders lodge
- Dental care
- Early childhood education and youth services
- Primary health care

Kelowa Edel

Kelowa is Anishinaabe from Manitoba. She moved to British Columbia in 1984 and has worked with Stó:lō in various capacities since 1993.

Kelowa is currently the Health Director at Stó:lō Service Agency. In that capacity Kelowa provides overall leadership and direction to the program including: management and supervision of staff and services; coordination, liaison and networking; implementation of programs; and technical support and assistance to staff. Kelowa builds and maintains relationships with all stakeholders and partners in the realm of Health Services.







Language Mini-lesson

Our language teacher Kecia Prevost led the group in a Halq'eméylem language lesson. We learned to play a Halq'eméylem language game much like rock, paper, scissors or cowboy, ninja, bear but slightly different.

First Kecia taught everyone how to count 1, 2, 3 – léts'e (1); islà:xw (2); ihì:xw (3)

Then she taught everyone how to say Kwitsel = Grizzly; Slahli = Lady; Swiyeqa = Hunter. She then taught everyone the rules of the game. Two people play the game at one time. The players stand back to back and count to three then jump and turn around showing and saying either Kwitsel, Slahli, or Swiyeqa. Kwitsel overcomes Slahli overcomes Swiyeqa overcomes Kwitsel. Lots of fun was had by all who participated in (or watched!)

the game.


