

Summary of Information

Environmental Management Law, 2017

Given the inherent right of Sq'ewá:lxw to self-government and stewardship of our lands, and as enabled by the Sq'ewá:lxw Land Code, and upon the advice of the Lands Advisory Committee, Sq'ewá:lxw Chief and Council, has enacted the Sq'ewá:lxw Environmental Management Law 2017. The Law was tabled at a duly convened meeting of Chief and Council on November 29, 2017 and passed by Council on November 29, 2017.

In the process of implementing jurisdiction over our land, Sq'ewá:lxw is enacting land management laws and creating policies with which we will fashion the community as envisioned by the people. Sq'ewá:lxw regards environmental sustainability as the foundation of a safe, healthy, and thriving community.

The purpose of the *Sq'ewá:lxw Environmental Management Law* is to ensure that the people's vision of a safe, prosperous, and sustainable community is obtained while caring for our land and water.

The Law is applicable to the whole area of the Reserves (Skawahlook IR# 1 and Ruby Creek IR# 2), to all Band Land, to all land held under Certificate of Possession, and to members and non-members.

The Environmental Management Law allows for:

- The preparation of an Environmental Management Plan;
- The preparation of an Emergency Management Plan;
- The prohibition of improper disposal of wastes, industrial wastes, and litter;
- The development and implementation of Sq'ewá:lxw Environmental Operating Procedures;
- Control of the movement, importation, and exportation of soils;
- The prohibition of the discharge of contaminants;
- Control of the handling, storage, and transportation of fuel and environmental contaminants;
- The remediation of contaminated sites;
- The issuing of Environmental Permits for the handling, treatment, transportation, storage and introduction of contaminants into the environment;
- The issuing of Environmental Orders and Remediation Orders; and
- Enforcement of the Law.
